- Dump buckets and pails immediately after use
- Drain and flip kiddie pools as soon as playtime is over

BE PREPARED

- Ensure your family members know what to do in an emergency situation
- Make contact information readily available for emergency services, poison control, and trusted neighbors and relatives
- Keep a well-stocked first aid kit
- Learn CPR
